

I'll never forget that moment. Standing there in a large board room with one of the longest tables I'd ever seen, I was feeling how different I was compared to the rest of the leaders in the room.

Then, the Executive Leader of my branch of the organization looked at me, smiled, and said, "Take a seat." The chair felt like it weighed 100 pounds as I pulled it out. I sat down, and he gave me a nod like I was made for that chair. I listened to the meeting begin, knowing my moment was coming to present to the board what could quite possibly be the greatest paradigm shift they'd heard in years. My stomach churned a bit- with nervousness, excitement, and a grasp of how there was no one like me at that table.

My moment came, and then it went. The presentation was received with enthusiasm, and I left the room feeling like a new chapter was about to begin.

But then it didn't.

Everything changed, the leader who literally gave me a seat at the leadership table was suddenly gone, and dreams had to move on, too.

Consequently, my voice - which had had a seat at the leadership table — now didn't have one. It was systematically silenced by forces outside of me and inside of me.

What I needed in those days was a community of women who could come alongside my leadership journey and help me lean into the significant questions I had. I needed women with more experience to show me what it looked like to strengthen and use my voice again- even when retreating felt more secure. I needed tools that would help me in practical and transformative ways as I sought to live obediently into the calling of God on my life.

I didn't know where they were, but I began searching — without them, I knew it wouldn't be long before I'd bow out. I found mentors, coaches, and friends. Their influence changed everything about my leadership journey. Their encouragement kept me in the battle. They're the ones who run alongside me and remind me this isn't a solo mission.

(En)Courage is your space to find the tools and the people that will change everything about your leadership journey. The information, encouragement, and challenges we'll encounter over the next two days might be the word from Him we need to stay in the battle. More than anything, I am praying that through this, you find some women who will run alongside you and remind you this is not a solo mission.

We're honored you're here with us. We think leadership looks really good on you. We believe your voice enriches this world.

We lead, friends. So lean in... Are you ready?
